Since 2005 School Grades are based on only matched standard curriculum students for calculating percentage of students "meeting higher standards". Results of ESE and LEP students are added to calculate percentage "making learning gains" and "adequate progress".

Since 2005 FCAT Writing scores are calculated by the percentage of students scoring 3.5 and above.

2006-2007 is the first year to include Science and "adequate progress of the lowest 25% for Mathematics" in School Grade calculations.

NOTE: If a school otherwise graded "C" or "B" does not demonstrate adequate progress for reading and math for two years in a row, the final grade may be reduced by one letter grade.

High Schools may earn a bonus of 10 points if 50% of 11th/12th graders pass the FCAT.
